Your Rockwell Automation Field Service Professional will provide In Scope services, listed below, during your drive startup. Startup and warranty service is provided during normal working hours. Out of scope services may be performed at an additional charge.

In Scope:

- Physical inspection and verification of proper drive and motor installation practices prior to the application of power
- Verification of external control wiring
- Confirmation of drive cabling to Motor, Line Feed, Isolation Transformer (if applicable)
- Incoming line and drive output grounding checks
- Voltage application, checkout, calibration, and testing of the drive as appropriate for the application
- Adjustment of operation parameters, within drive and motor design limitations, to values as appropriate for the application
- Operation of drive through speed range to verify proper performance
- Loading of network parameters in the drive
- Documentation of drive and motor nameplate information, application information, drive settings, and operating parameters

Out of Scope:

- External wiring and troubleshooting outside the drive. External wiring and troubleshooting is related to electrical or mechanical equipment outside the drive(s) or problems caused by external sources such as networks, electrical transients, corrosion, surface contaminants, excessive ambient temperatures, restricted air ventilation, abusive operation, etc
- Network troubleshooting and configuration
- Integration of the drive to control devices
- Drives that are part of a drives system
- Preventive Maintenance Services
- Stand-by time
