

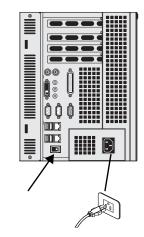

2 Connect peripherals.





The computer will boot to a Windows Setup Wizard.



4 Click Next to enter the Windows Setup Wizard.

5 Read and accept the End User License Agreement (EULA).

6 Gather this information and complete the Windows Setup Wizard.
